#### 2. Reason for revision

With respect to the consolidated operating performance forecast for the fiscal year ending March 31, 2026, the Company has revised upward its forecasts for operating revenue, operating income, and ordinary income, and revised downward its forecast for net income attributable to owners of the parent, reflecting factors such as revenue trends following the revision of rail fares and charges, the recording of losses associated with the cancellation of the project utilizing the space above the tracks at Hakata Station, and the impact of natural disaster.

Similarly, the non-consolidated performance forecast has been revised upward for operating revenue, operating income, and ordinary income, and revised downward for net income, for the same reasons noted above.

As for the annual dividend per share, the Company plans to maintain the previously announced level of \xi15, as disclosed on August 5, 2025, with the payout ratio expected to be 38.5%.
